*The first Individualized Application Phase weekend is scheduled for December 6-8, 2013. Specific weekend course dates for 2014-2015 are to be determined and will meet approximately seven times.

Program Format

The Transformative Leadership and Social Change program weekends are held Friday evenings 6:00 to 9:00 p.m., Saturdays 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and Sundays 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Between scheduled class sessions, students meet with their Transformative Practice Groups; however, each group decides the schedule for these meetings.

The eight core courses are taken in sequential order over the first two years of the program, followed by an individualized application phase consisting of four independent studies and the Project of Excellence. The program averages 36+ months for completion, depending on the pace you set when completing the individualized application phase. The maximum amount of time allowed to complete the program is 60 months.
